SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES FIRE AND POLICE COMMISSION MEETING October 29, 2025

CALL TO ORDER:

The special meeting was called to order at 5:58pm and followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Members present were Commissioners Pedersen, Lazansky and Keag. Also, present was Police Chief Dan Babich, Fire Chief Dan Manning and Village Manager Assistant John Schwarz.

NEW BUSINESS:

The only item of new business to discuss was the review of seniority points awarded for the fire lieutenant's promotional exam. After a discussion in executive session, Commissioner Lazansky made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Keag to approve the amended scores for seniority allowing seniority up to December 3, 2025. The motion passed unanimously, and the amended scores will be sent to lieutenant candidates to notify them.

OLD BUSINESS:

Commissioner Pedersen presented the Final Eligibility List for Police Officer and Commissioner Keag made a motion to approve. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lazansky and approved. Candidates will be sent a copy of the list, and the Commission will start working on processing the candidates to fill vacancies within the PD.

RECESS TO EXECUTIVE SESSION:

A motion was made by Commissioner Lazansky to adjourn to executive session for the purpose of discussing: Appointment, Employment, Compensation, Promotion and Discipline of Village Employees. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Keag and then the motion passed by a roll call vote taken with 3 "yes" votes and zero "no" votes. The BFPC members then recessed into executive session at 6:00pm. At 6:10 Commissioner Pedersen made a motion to adjourn the executive session and resume the meeting in open session. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lazansky and then the motion passed by a roll call vote taken with 3 "yes" votes and zero "no" votes.
